are fraught with flaws and contradictions on the one hand he emphasized the individualistic egalitarian pluralistic democratic and dynamic qualities of islam on the other his government enacted legislation and acquiesced in the activities of religious bodies that curtailed religious freedoms of both muslims and non muslims his ideas contributed to malaysia s worsening state of interethnic relations yet his insistence that every muslim had the right to speak for islam may have paradoxically prepared the ground for a future democratization of malaysian politics mahathir s islam is based on rigorous analysis of mahathir s speeches interviews and writings which the author is able to link to parallel processes elsewhere in the muslim world indonesia the middle east pakistan turkey and diaspora communities in the west mahathir s islamic discourse schottmann suggests must be read against the wider late twentieth century resurgence of religion in general and the post 1970s islamic revival in particular balanced in approach and engagingly written this book will be of interest to scholars and students of political science religious studies and others interested in malaysia southeast asia or mahathir himself
